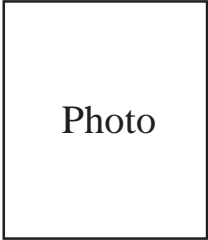
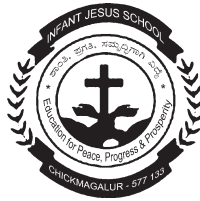

HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

"INFANT JESUS SCHOOL" is an undertaking of "THE CAPUCHIN FRIARS SERVICE SOCIETY®" The Motto of the School : "Education for peace, progress and Prosperity."

The Capuchin Friars who are the followers of St Francis of Assisi, who was born in Italy in the year 1181 and dedicated his entire life living and propagating the Universal Brotherhood, have drawn inspiration from their founder to live and work for the same brotherhood and to become instruments of Peace.

Our school is situated in the Western Ghats surrounded by the Coffee Estates and the ever green fields of Kadri- Midri Village in Chikmagalur District. Infant Jesus School being a Christian Minority Institution was established on 4th of June, 2005. Though the primary goal of the institution is to educate the Christian Children, yet it is open to everyone irrespective of Caste, creed and religion.

The school is under the management of Capuchin Friars Service Society®, which is registered under the society's registration Act of 1960 (Mysore Act No. 17 of 1960). All the members of this society are the Catholic Religious belonging to the order of Friars Minor Capuchin. They live the Gospel Values and render service to the people who are poor, needy and marginalized. Infant Jesus School has its focus on all round education with emphasis on personal growth and character formation along with integral values based development of young students.

The mission of the school is to draw inspiration from Jesus Christ and to show preferential love for the poor and the disadvantaged. It provides a unique educational experience to every child in a safe and supportive environment that promotes personal attitudes of self- discipline, motivation and excellence in learning. Expressing our oneness with all people we strive

to build an Educative Community of the Management, Staff, Students and Parents who will interact with one another with love, trust responsibility and a sense of belonging.

OUR MISSION:

Drawing inspiration from Jesus Christ we show preferential love for the poor and the disadvantaged, through our mission of Education. Infant Jesus School provides a unique educational experience to every child in a safe and supportive environment that promotes personal attitudes of self-discipline, motivation and excellence in learning. Expressing our oneness with all people, we strive to build an Educative Community of the Management, Staff, Students and parents who will interact with one another with love, trust responsibility and a sense of belonging.

CORE VALUES, AIMS & OBJECTIVES

1. Have faith in God, cultivate basic qualities of character and a sense of moral and spiritual values
2. Learn to respect parents, elders , teachers and authority

ADMISSIONS:

1. Management reserves to itself the right of admission.
2. Entrance exams are conducted for new admissions for class 1-8th Std.

3. The Admissions are done from May 2nd onwards. The minimum age for admission for LKG is 3 years 10 months and for 1st Std is 5 years 10 months.
4. New admission will be made subject to the vacancies in each class in the month of May.
5. **Every Student must bring;**
 - a. **A Transfer Certificate from a recognized school.**
 - b. **The Original Corporation/Panchayat Birth Certificate, if the child has not attended school before.**
 - c. **A recent 4 passport size photograph.**
 - d. **Aadhar card xerox (c)**
 - e. **Ration Card Xerox**
 - f. **Caste and Income Certificate**
 - g. **Student Pass book xerox**
 - h. **Come along with child**
6. A candidate who has attended any recognized school cannot be admitted without a leaving certificate from the school attended.
7. Special attention must be paid to entering correctly the name and date of birth of the child, caste and the parent's names. No changes in the date of birth or name will be permitted.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. The application for leave should be made on the pages set aside for the purpose in the school calendar.
2. **For every absence, a written statement signed by the parent/guardian is required on the day the pupil returns. If the student is absent for more than 3 days for reasons of ill health, a medical certificate from a doctor is required stating illness and fitness.**

3. All explanatory notes for absence and late arrival should be handed over to the Principal. No one who is late or has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the permission of the Principal.
4. Outside the vacation period, pupils are not granted leave. Hence prior permission should be sought for absence from the Principal for any reasons known or planned in advance.
5. Students will not be allowed to leave the school before the stipulated time unless parents/guardians present a written request to the headmaster.
6. Any student requiring leave for any part of the day on account of sudden illness or unavoidable circumstances should obtain the permission of the class teacher and the headmaster before leaving the school. Leave record signed by parent/ guardian should be submitted to the headmaster on the next working day.
7. No student will be allowed to leave the school once the attendance is marked.
8. Except the Parent / Guardian No one is allowed to take the child home for whatever reasons.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All the pupil must abide by the school code of conduct and discipline and must bear in mind the following points:-

1. Pupil should be punctual and regular.
2. Pupil should be in correct, neat, clean and tidy uniform with ID cards.
3. Books or Magazines not approved by the school authorities must not be brought into the school; in case they brought, they shall be confiscated.

4. Speaking in English is a “must” when in school campus. The respective language must be used during the language classes.
5. The primary civic duty is to guard public property. School property is public property and care should be taken to protect it. Any damage done to school property must be made good by the parent or guardian of the child.
6. Every student must have a minimum of 85% attendance to be eligible to appear for the annual exams/be promoted to the next class.
7. Students should not carry mobile phones to school, if found with mobiles, the same will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the academic year.
8. No Parent / Guardian will use abusive language to the teachers / institution.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. It is vital that changes in residence/office addresses and telephone number be communicated in writing to the office immediately when they occur.
2. Pupil are advised not to have private tuitions. Parents are urged to encourage their children to do their daily work diligently and honestly and to pay utmost attention to the studies in the class room. If there be real need for help and special attention, kindly contact the headmaster.
3. Parents are encouraged to have their children undergo medical examination regularly for general well-being specially dental, eye and ear care.
4. Collection of funds for whatever use is forbidden without prior permission of the headmaster.

5. The School is not responsible for the articles lost.
 - (a) It is not advisable or bring valuable articles like expensive watches, ornaments of gold or silver etc. to the school. Wearing of watches is allowed only from high school.
 - (b) Books, Tiffin carriers, sweaters should bear the name of the pupil and he/she will be the sole responsible person for its safe-keeping.
 - (c) No earing on one ear, No bracelets, bangles for boys for whatever reasons..
6. **Every student must have a copy of the school calendar and it should be brought to the school every day. Parents should carefully go through the calendar daily and sign their remarks when required.**
7. Each student's safety is a major concern of the school, There fore the following should be strictly observed;
 - a) Parents of pre-primary students are required to teach their children their names, address and telephone numbers by-heart..
 - b) If the child has to go to a place other than the normal one, a note from the parent must be sent to the school, requesting permission and stating the reason for a child to go to a different place after the school.
 - c) No one except the parents are allowed to meet the student during the school hours.
8. Perfect cleanliness is expected with regard to uniform.
9. Full uniform is must from 15th of June.

PARENT-TEACHER INTERACTIONS

1. The Co-operation and good will of the parents is an essential component of an effective parent-teacher

relationship in order to provide maximum educational opportunities for children. The school needs the involvement of parents in many of its activities.

2. Parents and guardians shall co-operate with the school by adhering to the rules and regulations as amended from time to time.
3. Parents should see that their children are dressed properly and neatly with the particular uniform prescribed for the day.
4. Parents are encouraged to give positive suggestions for the improvement of academic standards.
5. Parents are requested to supervise the daily Homework of their ward and duly sign their homework diary every day after the completion and counter check and thus co-operate with the teachers.
6. It is the duty of the parents to provide necessary infrastructure and material for their daily duties at home.
7. Children should not be kept at home or called for during working hours for unnecessary and trifle reasons. Progress cards of the students after each semestral examination are to be collected by the parents personally from the class teacher and to be duly signed in the presence of the teacher. This will help the parent-teacher to have a dialogue about the ward and take adequate steps to improve the overall growth of the ward. Marks cards after the test must be duly signed (e) and returned by the next day.
9. **Parents are absolutely forbidden to enter the classrooms when the classes are on.**
10. **No parent is allowed to walk on the verandha or enter the classroom for any reason. They are advised to contact the school office or principal's chamber for any necessity.**
11. Parents/guardian are requested to make known their grievances/complaints in writing directly to the principal and not to the teacher concerned.

12. There will be only parent teacher meeting at the beginning of the academic year.
13. Parents teachers association office bearers will be nominated by the management.

EVALUATION & PROMOTION

Regular unit tests, monthly tests and terminal examinations are held each year. Promotion is based on total performance at these tests, exams and regular attendance. It is the policy of the school not to fail a student as far as possible. At the same time a student who has not acquired the necessary skills to study in a higher class may not be promoted.

Infant Jesus School is interested in providing additional possible facilities for slow or weak learners. However parents must cooperate with the school management to acquire the necessary skills. Please see the calenders for the test and examination purposes.

No Re-tests will be given for whatever reasons. However for grave reasons, the school considers possibilities of an alternative.
